# **Small Equipment**



### **Loppers and Saws**



Use: The loppers and saws are for removal of buckthorn and other invasive species that out-compete beneficial native plants.

#### **Weed Wrenches**



Use: The weed wrenches are for the removal of buckthorn at its roots. The wrench will allow for entire stump removal of buckthorn and any other invasive species.

#### **Hand Seeder**



Use: The hand seeder works for seeding small areas of warm or cool season grass.

### **Red Hand Seeder**



Use: The red hand seeder works for seeding small areas of cool season grasses. It utilizes a mechanical handle.

## **Rental Information:**

The Scott Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) in Jordan, MN has equipment available to rent for use on land in Scott County. For more information or to be added to the equipment rental schedule, call the Scott SWCD at 952-492-5425.

### **Rental Rates:**

- Seeders and drills are \$8 an acre, and require a \$50 deposit. A non-refundable drop charge of \$120 is required.
  - Drop-charge covers the first 15 acres of use.
  - The \$50 security deposit will be returned when the equipment is returned without damage.
- Loppers and saws are a \$25 deposit.
- Weed wrenches and hand seeders are a \$50 deposit.
  - All security deposits will be returned when the equipment is returned without damage.
